Dropbox Campus Cup Program Terms NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW.

- 1. **Sponsor.** Dropbox, PO Box 77767, San Francisco, CA 94107.
- 2. **Timing.** Individuals may participate in the Dropbox Campus Cup Program ("Program") from September 17, 2015 to December 14, 2015 at 11:59pm Pacific Time (the "Program Period"). Participants must determine the appropriate beginning and ending times in the Program Period for their locations. The Sponsor's computer is the official time keeping device for the Program.
- 3. **Eligibility.** There are two parts to eligibility:
 - A. First, each participant ("Participant") must:
 - i. Be fourteen (14) years or older;
 - ii. Have a Dropbox Basic or Dropbox Pro account ("Eligible Account"), or sign up for one;
 - iii. Be actively enrolled in or work for a Higher Education Institution that is not among the Excluded Domains and have an active email address provisioned by that Higher Education Institution ("Eligible Email Address");
 - iv. Have access to the Dropbox website www.dropbox.com; and
 - v. Sign up for the Program with an Eligible Account and Eligible Email Address (a "Verified Account", when complete) as described in Section 4 below.
 - B. Second, to be an eligible Participant ("Eligible Participant"), Participant's Higher Education Institution must have at least twenty-five Participants signed up for the Program by the end of the Program Period and not be among the Excluded Domains (an "Eligible Higher Education Institution").

A "Higher Education Institution" is a higher education institute, college, university, or the equivalent of a university (for clarity, high schools (or the equivalent of high schools) and levels below aren't Higher Education Institutions under the Program). "Excluded Domains" are mit.edu, si.edu, and fullerton.edu (including all associated subdomains, e.g., math.mit.edu). Email addresses in the Excluded Domains aren't eligible to participate in the Program, and also are not eligible to be used as verifying email addresses.

Dropbox for Business ("DfB") accounts aren't eligible to participate in the Program. If a Participant's Dropbox account associated with his/her Eligible Email Address is a DfB account, the Participant may sign up for the Program by verifying an Eligible Account with his/her Eligible Email Address.

"Authorized Account Holder" is the natural person who's provisioned an email address by an Internet access provider, online service provider, or other organization responsible for provisioning email addresses for the domain associated with the email address. All other entries won't be considered. The Program is subject to all applicable federal, provincial, state, and local laws and is void where prohibited. All Participants agree to be bound by these Terms and the decisions of the Sponsor.

4. How to Participate; Prize.

To participate, Eligible Participants must follow the instructions at www.dropbox.com/campuscup to sign up for the Program.

Eligible Participants may begin to accumulate points for their Eligible Higher Education Institution as described below in Section 5. Eligible Participants will receive a two (2) year free trial of storage space earned in the Program, which will be added to existing storage space in an Eligible Participant's Verified Account. Storage space received is not transferable or redeemable for cash and must be accepted as granted, with no substitutions of any kind, except by the Sponsor.

ANY STORAGE SPACE RECEIVED FROM THE PROGRAM WILL EXPIRE ON THE EARLIER OF (I) JANUARY 1, 2018 OR (II) WHEN A VERIFIED ACCOUNT BECOMES A DFB ACCOUNT.

5. **Participation Points and Thresholds.** Eligible Participants can earn storage space by earning points for their Eligible Higher Education Institution ("Participation Points"), as follows:

Downloading and installing the Dropbox desktop client, and logging in to the Dropbox desktop client	20
Downloading and installing the Dropbox mobile app, and logging in to the Dropbox mobile app	5
Creating a new Dropbox shared folder	10

Creating a Dropbox file request	5
Invite others at an Eligible Higher Education Institution to participate in the Program within the first week of signing up for the Program	3 per invitation accepted via your referral link within first week you sign up for the Program
Invite others at an Eligible Higher Education Institution to participate in the Program	1 per invitation accepted via your referral link

Dropbox will tally Participation Points for each Eligible Higher Education Institution. Each Eligible Higher Education Institution will be assigned four numerical thresholds. These numerical thresholds will be different for each Eligible Higher Education Institution because the number of points required to reach a threshold has been statistically normalized to account for the fact that schools with larger enrollments are able to earn points faster than schools with smaller enrollments. The required thresholds for an Eligible Participant's Eligible Higher Education Institution will be listed on www.dropbox.com/campuscup once an Eligible Participant is logged in to his/her Verified Account. Once the Eligible Participants from an Eligible Higher Education Institution have cumulatively earned enough Participation Points to surpass one of the four thresholds, each Eligible Participant from that Eligible Higher Education Institution will receive an email confirming the additional storage space added to his/her Verified Account. The storage space increases for passing each threshold will be as follows:

Released parties aren't responsible or liable for: (a) technical failures of any kind; (b) any incorrect information or other printing, distribution, or production errors in the Program, whether caused by human or technical error; (c) any injury or damage to Participants related to or resulting from participating in the Program; (d) delay in receipt of, use or misuse of, any storage space; or (e) unauthorized intervention in the Program. If, for any reason, the Program isn't capable of running as planned, including because of, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, force majeure, or any other cause beyond the control of Sponsor which may corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the Program, Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Program. Sponsor reserves the right to change these Program Terms at any time, with or without notice.

- 8. **Privacy.** By participating in the Program, Participants consent to the collection, use and disclosure of their personal information as described at www.dropbox.com/privacy, and as is more specifically set forth in the Program materials and in these Terms. Participants consent to allow Sponsor to use their information for the purposes of administering and promoting the Program and servicing their free trials of storage space.
- 9. **Miscellaneous.** These Terms are governed by the laws of the State of California without regard to its conflict of law provisions. If a provision of these Terms is found unenforceable, the remaining provisions of the Terms will remain in full effect. Sponsor may assign its rights to its affiliates, subsidiaries, or successor in interest.
- 10. **Disputes.** Except where prohibited, Participants agree that any and all disputes related to the Program will be submitted to the American Arbitration Association for individual binding arbitration in the San Francisco, California, USA area, before one arbitrator to be mutually agreed upon by both parties, under its rules then in effect. The parties agree to share equally in the arbitration costs incurred.
